

Anchorage Historic Preservation Commission

Minutes

April 21, 2009

The meeting was called to order by the Chairman, Bill Wetherton at 6:00 p.m. Commission members present were Bill Wilkinson, Becky Miller, Clyde Ensor, and B J Elliott; Advisors Peg Revell, Cindy Albright-Parrish, and Mildred Ewen. Visitors were Anna and Bradley Roseberry, Lucy Spickard, Robin Hughes, Brian Rublein, Page Ochs, Patsy Harkess, Rita Carlisle, Nique Freeze, Ken Putlak, Debbie Doering, and Greta Chessler.

The minutes were read and approved with the following corrections: paragraph one, Dolken and Cadden were misspelled.

Greta Chessler, President of the Anchorage Garden Club, presented plans for an arch to be built 15 feet behind the brick archway at Hobbs Chapel, 11705 Osage Road. The arch is to be of wrought iron and will be 10 feet tall by 3 feet deep and the 2 side panels fill 4 feet wide. B J moved to approve the arch and Clyde Ensor seconded. All agreed.

Ken Putlak came before the Commission. He installed new vinyl windows at 12007 Locust Lane Drive without the approval of the Commission. Mr. Putlak has never appeared before the Commission involving this house. Mr. Wilkinson explained that the Commission has never approved vinyl windows in the Historic District. Vinyl clad wood windows with SDL are accepted. Becky moved that Mr. Putlak be required to remove the windows and replace them with acceptable ones. B J seconded and all concurred. He was told by Chairman Wetherton that he could appeal to the City Council and after that to Circuit Court.

There being no further business the meeting was adjourned at 7:12 p.m.
