

Anchorage Historic Preservation Commission

Minutes from April 19, 2011

The meeting was called to order by Chairman Bill Wetherton at 6:00 PM. Commission members in attendance were Clyde Ensor, Tony Bayus, Becky Miller, BJ Elliott, Bill Wilkinson and Dan Fultz. Visitors included Jay Foley, Kristin DeLong and Kevin Grangier.

Nancy and Bill Wilkinson, 1701 Evergreen Rd., requested approval to replace roofing with asphalt shingles. They had been previously approved for copper to replace the existing tin. Although commission members would prefer copper, they realize the exorbitant cost. Wilkinson excused himself from the vote. Ensor moved for approval; Elliott seconded. The motion carried with abstention from Bayus.

Jay Foley, Evergreen Real Estate, 11507 Park Rd., requested approval for a patio awning at the Sea Hag. The columns will be aluminum, wrapped with wood or Azak. A heat system is not planned. Fultz excused himself from the vote. Miller moved for approval. Bayus seconded and the motion carried.

BJ and Bob Elliott, 11107 Owl Creek Lane, requested approval to replace the wood-shingled roof with asphalt shingles. BJ excused himself from the vote. Fultz moved for approval; Wilkinson seconded and the motion carried.

Wetherton announced that the Kentucky Heritage Council is offering sessions in July and in the fall on "tax incentives" for restoration of historic properties. Commission members will receive more information via email.
