

**Anchorage Historic Preservation Commission
Minutes from Regular Meeting
September 14, 2009**

Camilla Schroeder, 12300 Holly Lane, requested approval to change sliding doors to windows. Flat columns will be used after removing the sliding glass doors and adding windows of the same height. Ensor moved for approval. Following a second from Elliott, the motion carried.

Susan and Mark Larson, 12343 Forest School Lane, presented plans for enlarging a brick patio and adding a seating wall. Limestone will match the existing patio. Stone matching the face of the house will be used for the wall. Brick steps leading out to the grass will be added. Brick will match existing. Elliott moved for approval with a second from Ensor. All approved.

Courtney and Bruce Lake, 12627 Osage Rd., requested approval for the addition of a window, door and siding to their guest house. The storage room will become useable space. The garage door will be changed to an entry door. One bathroom will be added. Hardy-board siding will match the existing. Trim and brackets will be wood. Fultz moved for approval. Elliott seconded and all agreed.
