

**MINUTES

The Council Members in attendance were: Roger Durham, Dan Heiskell, Susan Mitchell, and Brian Rublein. Council Members elected Susan Mitchell to preside at the meeting. Also in attendance were Assistant to the Mayor Alice McKinley, Director of Public Works Erwin Booth, and City Clerk Nan Schlindwein.

Susan Mitchell called the meeting to order at 6:05 p.m.

**MINUTES**

McKinley presented five cost and culvert options for the replacement of 12 irreparable culverts in the City's sewer project area. McKinley reported that Bill Wetherton recommended the iron ductile pipe versus the other options because of its longevity and durability. Joe Roehrig, the construction manager for MAC Derrick Grant, and Engineer John Beyke had commented to McKinley that the iron ductile pipe would be a good choice, even though the cost was higher than others.

Durham moved to accept Option #4: Culvert removal and replacement with Ductile Iron pipe including stone backfill – cost \$60,300.00. Heiskell seconded the motion and the vote was unanimous.

The meeting adjourned at 6:08 p.m.
