The Council members in attendance were: Brian Rublein, Susan Mitchell, Neil Ramsey, and Roger Durham. Mayor Hewitt presided. Also in attendance were City Clerk Nan Schlindwein; Police Chief Chris Winders; City Attorney John McGarvey; Treasurer Renee Major; and guests Stephen Kottkamp and Diane McAllister.

Mayor Hewitt called the meeting to order at 6:05 p.m.

**MINUTES**

The minutes from the September 14, 2009, Regular Meeting of City Council were presented. Mitchell made the motion to accept them, which was seconded by Durham, and the minutes were unanimously approved.

**TREASURER'S REPORT**

The City's check register and financial report for September 2009 were presented.

**POLICE REPORT**

Chief Chris Winders presented the September 2009 police report. Ramsey asked the Chief a question about residential alarm systems. Winders stated that a large number of home alarm systems in the City wire directly into the police station, by-passing the monitoring company, saving between a minute and a half and two minutes in police response time.
