

**MINUTES

The Council members in attendance were Cece Hagan, Dan Heiskell, Susan Mitchell, and Brian Rublein. Also in attendance were Assistant to the Mayor/City Clerk Alice McKinley, Treasurer Renee Major, Police Lieutenant Brian Warren, Clerk/Receptionist Sandra Kunzler, and guests Diane McAllister and Steve Kottkamp.

Mayor Hewitt called the meeting to order at 6:01 p.m.

MINUTES

The minutes from the September 12, 2011, Meeting of City Council were presented. Heiskell motioned to approve the minutes; Mitchell seconded. The minutes were unanimously approved.

TREASURER'S REPORT

The City's September Check Register and Monthly Financial Report were presented for review. There were no questions for Major.

POLICE REPORT

The September Police Activity Report was shared with Council. Mitchell inquired about the increase in missing persons, and was advised they were all youth from Bellewood. Warren noted that when the teens take off, they usually head west towards the Circle-K or can be found in the lake area.

HISTORIC PRESERVATION COMMISSION

Minutes from the Commission's September 20, 2011, meeting were presented to City Council. The Mayor asked what Evergreen Real Estate planned for the old flower shop (Hayes House) and Mitchell indicated Kevin Grangier is opening a very upscale, high-end footwear boutique.

FORESTRY BOARD

The minutes from the Forestry Board's September 12, 2011 meeting were submitted for review. McAllister had nothing to add and there were no questions for her.

OLD BUSINESS

Last month Ramsey requested that AT&T Wireless be approached about paying for a physical tower inspection. McKinley reported that they had agreed to the City's request. The inspection is required prior to their conversion from 3G to 4G equipment which will add six additional antennas and considerable weight to the tower. McKinley also noted that T-Mobile has completed installation of the fiber optics cable to the tower.
