**ANCHORAGE JOINS OTHER LOCAL GOVERNMENTS  
ON GOVDEALS**

As on-line auction sites such as Ebay draw millions of consumers looking for unique finds and great deals, Anchorage has joined forces with GovDeals to auction off surplus items from the police and maintenance departments and City Hall. GovDeals, a privately owned Montgomery-based auction site, works much the same as Ebay but all sellers are either local or state governments. They currently tout a membership of about 600 government entities across the United States. The site organizes the items into 54 categories ranging from police cars and fire trucks to jewelry and computers.
