ORDINANCE NO. 1, SERIES 2012

**AN ORDINANCE ALLOWING PUBLIC ACCESS AND USE AND ACCEPTING
MAINTENANCE AND OPERATIONAL RESPONSIBILITY FOR FOREST SCHOOL
LANE**

WHEREAS, the property owners of the subdivision within the City known as Forest School Estates have requested that the City accept a maintenance agreement (“Maintenance Agreement”) for Forest School Lane (“Street”) within the subdivision, which Street is indicated on a plat of record at Plat and Subdivision Book 48, Page 2, in the Office of the Clerk of Jefferson County, Kentucky; and

WHEREAS, said Street has been open to the unrestricted use of the general public for more than five consecutive years; and

WHEREAS, the Council deems it to be in the best interest of the City to accept responsibility for all normal operation, maintenance, and repair of the Street:

NOW, THEREFORE, be it ordained by the City of Anchorage that:

1. The Street known as Forest School Lane, and indicated on a plat of record at Plat and Subdivision Book 48, Page 2, in the Office of the Clerk of Jefferson County, Kentucky, is hereby open to public use and maintained and operated by the City of Anchorage; and
2. The City hereby accepts the Maintenance Agreement (a copy of which is attached hereto as Exhibit “A” and incorporated herein by reference), and approves its due execution.

This ordinance shall be effective upon its passage and publication as required by law.
