

WAGNER PARK RULES

The City welcomes and encourages the “casual use” of Wagner Park by all residents of Anchorage. These activities (e.g. picnics, family gatherings, photo settings, etc.) may occur anytime and without notice.

Planned events at Wagner Park require a permit.

A permit is required if an event will include any of the following:

- a. 50 or more attendees
- b. Structures such as tents, porta-potties, etc.
- c. Amplified music
- d. Generator(s)

Permitted events are limited to 6 – 7 per year with no more than 2 events in any one calendar month.

1. There will be a **permit fee of \$250.00** to be fully refunded after the event as long as all “permit rules” (#s 2-11 below) have been followed. If the event was not in compliance, the City will keep the fee and apply it to the beautification and/or improvement of Wagner Park at the City Council’s discretion.
2. Neighbors of Wagner Park (names and addresses provided by City Hall staff) must be notified by U.S. Mail by event organizers of all events within 24 hours of the City’s granting a permit for such an event.
3. Live music and/or other loud noise: All events at Wagner Park are subject to existing commercial Anchorage noise ordinances. Amplified sound speakers should be oriented towards the center of the property.
4. End time of 10 p.m.: Permitted events will be restricted to daytime use, defined as from 30 minutes before dawn to 10:00 p.m.
5. 100 or less total people to attend the event.
6. Defined Parking Rules
 - a) No parking on north side of Osage Road and no parking at all on Osage Circle.
 - b) Tires off pavement on Osage Road (south side).
 - c) Permittee must provide parking plan based on parking rules.
 - d) Someone monitors parking to ensure rules are followed.
7. Location of tents, porta-potties, and other structures must be approved by City Hall before erected and/or installed.

8. Tents, porta-potties, tables, etc. may be erected within one business day before the event and must be torn down and removed within one business day after the event. Structures must be set back at least 50 ft. from the property line.
9. Total cleanup by 5 p.m. of the following day. Trash and other debris must be entirely removed from the site within one business day after the event.
10. All permitted events will be required to hire an off-duty policeman to be on duty during the entirety of the event to facilitate ingress and egress, and to maintain safety.
11. Comply quickly with any police request.
